## Purpose

To make the entire RMRT campus look esthetically pleasing, to show community pride, and to set an example to other businesses in downtown Grand Lake

## Timeframe

The week before opening night of the first show of the season until the day after the last show of the fall season. End-of-Season cleanup is done as part of "*The Big Clean*" AKA "End of Season Theatre Set Plaza Outdoor Cleanup"

## Time Required

- 2-3 hours at beginning of season – planting phase
- .5 hours weekly to deadhead flowers – maintenance phase
- 1-2 hours at end of season – clean-up phase. See "*The Big Clean*"

## Possible Tasks

### ***4 window boxes and flower pots by main entrance***

- Plant and fertilize flowers/plants
- Water plants as needed
- Deadhead flowers approximately once per week by clipping the stem close to the bottom of the wilted flowers (do not just pull the flower off the seed pod)
- Re-attach window boxes to wall as needed
- End of season – remove and dispose of plants. Flower pots by main entrance

## Provided by RMRT

- Flowers for planters
- Hand trowel, hand rake, watering can, buckets, broom (stored in Garden Shed at Off-Broadway)
- Potting soil (stored in Garden Shed at Off-Broadway)
- Fertilizer (stored in Garden Shed at Off-Broadway)
- Dumpster

***Provided by Volunteer***

- Garden gloves
- Knee pads if desired
- Scissors for deadheading
- Bring your own tools if desired
- Hat
- Water/snacks

**Skills Required**

- Self-motivation
- Like working with plants and familiarity with water and fertilizer requirements
