Purpose

- Mow and weed whack grass as needed
- Pick up trash throughout grounds (front and back)
- Spray Roundup on weeds in driveways and parking areas as needed
- Butt buckets are to be emptied by the smokers using the buckets
- Curbside strip – weed, pick up trash, and mulch as needed
