Purpose

To make the entire RMRT campus look esthetically pleasing, to show community pride, and to set an example to other businesses in downtown GL

Timeframe

The week before opening night of the first show of the season until the day after the last show of the Fall season. Start earlier IF the weather is warm enough that plants won't die from frost

Time Required

- 2-3 hours at beginning of season – planting phase
- ½ hour per week – maintenance phase
- 2-3 hours at end of season

Possible Tasks

- Plant and fertilize flowers/plants
- Sweep area around barrels
- Coordinate with Marilyn/Dennis re: drip system schedule
- Deadhead flowers approximately once per week by clipping the stem close to the bottom of the wilted flowers (do not just pull the flower off the seed pod)
- Replant flowers as necessary
- Water flowers by hand as necessary
- Remove trash, gum, cigarette butts, etc. as needed
- Fertilize as needed
- End of season – remove all plants, trash, etc. and dispose appropriately. Sweep around area of the barrel. This is done in conjunction with "The Big Clean" AKA "End of Season Theatre Set Plaza Outdoor Cleanup."

Equipment

- Flowers for planters
- Hand trowel, hand rake, watering can, buckets, broom (stored in Garden Shed at Off-Broadway)
- Potting soil (stored in Garden Shed at Off-Broadway)
- Fertilizer (stored in Garden Shed at Off-Broadway)
- Dumpster

Provided by Volunteer

- Garden gloves
- Knee pads if desired

- Scissors for deadheading
- Bring your own garden tools if desired

- Self-motivated
- Like working with plants and have some knowledge of plants that will grow in the Grand Lake environment, water and fertilizer requirements
