



## 2021 YOUTH THEATRE REVIVAL!

Students will develop skills and expand imagination in small ensembles that will work together toward the presentation of a cabaret-style, one-act musical theatre performance. The Rep's Youth Theatre Revival is designed to bring back the collaborative spirit of our program while adhering to COVID-19 safety guidelines.

### **SESSION ONE - July 5 - 17**

Session 1-A: Ages 7-12. Runs 9:00a – noon at RMRT  
Session 1-B: Ages 13-18. Runs 1:00p – 4:00p at RMRT  
Performances: July 17, at 12 noon – Session 1-A (kids)  
July 17 at 4:00p – Session 1-B (teens)

### **SESSION TWO - July 19 - 31 (No camp July 23)**

Session 2-A: Ages 7-12. Runs 9:00a – noon at RMRT  
Session 2-B: Ages 13-18. Runs 1:00p – 4:00p at RMRT  
Performances: July 31 at 12 noon – Session 2-A (kids)  
July 31 at 4:00p – Session 2-B (teens)

### **Youth Theatre Revival Kids' Program      Ages 7-12      \$300      Capacity: up to 20 students split into two ensembles**

This two-week workshop will promote teamwork and collaboration among our younger students. They will exercise their imaginations through storytelling and build coordination through dance. Directors will help students expand and harness their physical expression and introduce music fundamentals, including group musical numbers with singing and dancing. The Rep's Youth Theatre Revival is sure to spark an interest in the arts for a lifetime!

### **Youth Theatre Revival Teen Program      Ages 13-18      \$300      Capacity: up to 20 students split into two ensembles**

Teens will work on building ensemble through trust while developing strength, balance, and physical confidence. They will free the body to recognize and act on impulses and expand their vocal possibilities while refining music technique. The program will include opportunities for students to shape the final performance through self-expression and creativity, and the final performance will include both group musical numbers and opportunities for solos.

### **Performances**

Our cabaret-style performances will address themes relevant to the last 18 months. Musical numbers will be rehearsed in 10-person ensembles that will combine into 20-person numbers during dress rehearsal as to create age-group cohesion. RMRT performers will perform alongside campers in a few select numbers. The kids' performance will include a short story adapted for RMRT students by Samantha Beach Kiley, our resident playwright & education director; she will also create an original short play for the teens.

### **Safety Precautions**

By working primarily in small ensembles of 10 students, we will promote social distancing in most of our exercises. Masking requirements will follow County and State guidelines and rules established by instructors when sessions begin. Our safety protocols include keeping the two ensembles separate until the last two days of the program, when they will come together to rehearse the final show.
